## **Superintendent of Schools**

#### **Information and Exploration**

## 1. Summer School 2015 Report

Dr. Heidenreich stated how we are one of the few districts left still offering Summer School. He thanked the staff and Dr. Pompilio and commended them on a job well done.

Dr. Troisi stated that the program was most successful with 1,029 students exclusive of Drivers Ed.; with 7 out of 10 seniors graduating, and many students participating in the jumpstart program.

Trustee Trogel asked about how many out of district students attended; whereas, Dr. Troisi replied that there were 3.

#### 2. Middle School Assessment Results

Dr. Troisi explained that out of the 18 districts in the Southwest Nassau quadrant, the district was as good if not better, than most, stating that comparisons are hard to figure due to the percentages of children opting out in each district. He also stated, that even with inconclusive results, the district and its staff members, along with students and parents, are forging ahead with new curriculum projects and online accessories.

Mr. Odell explained, with the exception of a few minor positions, that staffing is complete and ready in place for the first day of school.

#### 4. What's New for 2015-16

Dr. Loper stated that the Business office was moving along closing and opening the new school year keeping in mind the next budget. Capital projects are moving forward and being completed as well as preparing for the State audit that will take place at the end of September.

Trustee Stris asked if any Board member will be attending the audit as where Dr. Chiachiere explained that he will be there as the Board representative.

Dr Troisi stated how teachers were working on new curriculums: economics, AP history, common core algebra, common core algebra 2, and geometry; for the past few days there has been professional development in the district and it will be a continuing effort throughout the school year.

Mr Odell once again stated that staff is fully in place, following with the extra staffing approved in this year's budget.

Dr. Heidenreich explained that with this year's budget, the district was back to the level of staffing from several years ago.

#### **Attorney's Report**

Greg Guercio, attorney for the District, presented a report on a recent decision where the Third Circuit held that suspending an employee with pay pending an internal investigation does not constitute an adverse employment action under Title VII of the Civil Rights Action of 1964 which prohibits an employer from discriminating against an individual on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, or national origin. This ruling is consistent with previous decisions from numerous other Circuit courts including the Second Circuit which has jurisdiction over New York.
