There were two tied low bidders, one of which is located on Long Island. As Board Policy allows that consideration may be given to a local business the Business Committee recommends the bid be awarded to Advantage Music, Lake Ronkonkoma who has offered us 40% off the publisher's list price for sheet music, choral octavos, and band and orchestra arrangements. Two bidders were disqualified for not following bid instructions. (Bid #13/14-04)
