# C. Approval of Independent Auditing Services

Be it resolved, upon recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, in accordance with the Board of Education policy 6700, that the Request for Proposal from D'Arcangelo & Co., LLP. for Independent Auditing Services be approved by the Board of Education at a cost of \$40,600. for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017.
