#### 1. Preliminary June 2013 End of Year Report

Dr. Thomas Troisi shared that the results from the June, 2013 regents examinations were the strongest that he has seen over the last seven years.

Trustee Trogel asked if staff looks at the difference in numbers from year to year? Dr. Troisi responded that they do; looking at building to building, teacher to teacher, department to department, etc.

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#### 2. June 2013 Graduations

The Superintendent shared that all of the graduation ceremonies went very well. Central High School did a pilot of holding their ceremony off campus at the Tilles Center at C.W. Post University. Dr. Pompilio, Principal of Central, has asked that this become permanent. Dr. Heidenreich said that he has been asked why North and South were not held off campus. Because of the number of students at Central, an indoor graduation needs to move to Memorial's gym where there is no air conditioning.

Dr. Heidenreich asked the Board of Education for direction to look at other venues. Board President Antonelli polled the Board and the consensus is to look at other venues. The Superintendent also asked Maureen Henry, Principal of South, and Cliff Odell, Principal of North, to feel out parents at their PTA meetings to see if there is an interest in their buildings to look at off campus graduation ceremonies.

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#### 3. 2013 Summer School Program

Dr. Jennifer Gallagher, Director of Summer School, shared with the Board and community that Summer School began on Monday, July 8th with a smooth opening. There were 782 students enrolled in summer school which is a decrease, however there was the elimination of the enrichment program and some of the 7th and 8th grade programs.

The summer music program and driver education program are also up and running. There is a large decrease in the enrollment for driver education which most likely is due to the cost for the program.

Trustee Chiachiere asked Dr. Heidenreich and Board President Antonelli to set up a day and time so that he could visit the Summer School Program. Dr. Heidenreich said that he would check into dates and let the Board know.

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#### 4. Rifle and Bowling

Dr. Heidenreich provided the community with a review of past Board Meeting discussions regarding the Rifle Team. At the May meeting, there was a 5-4 vote to expend \$8,000 - \$10,000 for non-lead air rifle only. If the 5-4 vote stands, there is no need to discuss this further; the Board needs to focus on education. The Superintendents recommendation for any additional funds is to bring back teachers and lower class size. Trustee Iadevaio stated that he had gone to Albany and lobbied for additional funds, specifically to be used for the Rifle and Bowling Teams. Trustee Jacobs asked how much of these additional funds would be used to bring back the rifle team and bowling team for one year? Dr. Heidenreich said about \$40,000. Trustee Iadevaio said that it should be clear that this is only for one year; the parents need to fundraise to retain the teams after this year. Otherwise, they will be gone.

Trustee Jacobs asked the Superintendent for his recommendation. Dr. Heidenreich said that his recommendation is not to do this. The money should be used to lower class size and restore programs; that is how we fulfill the goals and objectives of the District. The additional funds would cover the expense of adding back about 3-4 sections which affects about 100 students. The Board adopted the budget with an 8 - 1 vote. The budget did not include funding for bowling and rifle. The community approved that budget and now, 2 months later, to go back and say that the money is there now brings about a credibility issue with the public.

Trustee Torres said that she disagreed with the Superintendent in that it appeared the community was coming back to support the money being used for the rifle and bowling team. Dr. Heidenreich said no, it is a very small portion of the community that is supporting this. Investing in education better serves the children. Board members, administrators and himself attended various meetings during the budget season and told the community that any extra funding received would go back to education.

Trustee DiSibio asked if the additional monies are directly from Trustee Iadevaio's efforts? Dr. Heidenreich responded that the district always gets "bullet" aid but not sure how much the amount was impacted. Trustee Jacobs felt that what if we give the teams a year to fundraise, they aren't able to raise the funds needed to sustain the team? Its then been a waste of the money.
