Information and Exploration

Dr. Heidenreich acknowledged and congratulated Dr. Joseph Pompilio for running an effective summer school program and a dignified summer graduation where seventeen students received their diplomas.

1. Summer School 2014 Report

Ds. Jennifer Gallagher discussed the success of this year's summer school programs with more than four hundred students in the music program and over one hundred in driver's education. Seventeen students received their diplomas at Summer School Graduation in August. A new component of on-line classes was very helpful to the success of these students and this program will be offered in the future.

Dr. Troisi, while not having specific numbers to date, stated the District on a whole was at the top proficiency rate (25%) of the schools in the Southwest quadrant of Long Island. Two programs to assist teachers in the following year will be the "Junior Great Book" and "Go Math" programs.

3. Staffing Update

Dr. Nekulak shared that the District will start with a full staff except for one instructional vacancy (a candidate backed out the morning of this meeting). Dr. Heidenreich thanked Dr. Nekulak for her hard work that starts out in March of each year.

4. What's New for 2014-15

Dr. Heidenreich shared that this is the first school year that the District is starting without any new school mandates; the first in three years.

Dr. Troisi shared that the District will have a partnership with Hofstra University where ninth graders will get a head start on a science research initiative. Students will take field trips to Hofstra in order to make contacts with professors for mentoring.

In technology, the seventh and eighth grade ESL and Special Ed students at North will continue using Ipads in their curricula. Students will also go forward using the credit recovery program with online courses.

Dr. Loper shared that the two main capital projects (Memorial's newly paved parking lot and South's new track) have both been completed in a timely manner.

Other projects have been done in each of the schools: North had its gym floors resurfaced, and sprinklers and black top were repaired.

South received soundproofing in some classrooms along with new gym locker spindles.

At Central, the auditorium was repainted and concrete work was completed and at Memorial there was one delay in

the replacement of the gym ceiling, but this project is still moving forward.
