Attorney's Report

Sullivan v. New York State Division of Human Rights, 160 A.D.3d 1395 (4th Dept. 2018) addresses the legal standard applicable to school districts regarding the obligation to accommodate an employee with a disability and the prohibition against discrimination.

A teacher filed a complaint alleging she was discriminated against by her school district employer based on her age, disability, and gender after she unsuccessfully filed a grievance challenging her involuntarily transfer from the high school to an elementary school. She alleged the transfer was an adverse employment action as she had always had

outstanding performance evaluations and also alleged the district failed to reasonably accommodate her disability of anxiety and depression. The State Division of Human Rights dismissed her complaint and found no probable cause existed to support a finding of discrimination. The employee appealed the decision to the State Supreme Court and then to the Appellate Division.

The Appellate Division ruled the Division of Human Rights had a rational basis to conclude the transfer in this circumstance was not an adverse employment action regardless of the employee's preference to remain in her current position. The Court upheld the Division's determinations there was no probable cause to support a finding of discrimination, and thus ruled the complaint was properly dismissed.


